Universal Fit Buckets

"Slip on the forks" attachment buckets or also known as Universal Fit buckets could be used with whichever model or design of extendable reach lift truck. Standard universal lift truck buckets attach to forks which are up to six inches wide and are forty eight inches long. Larger fork pockets can be ordered via an account executive upon request.

As universal fit lift truck buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the equipment and are much less susceptible to damage. These buckets are likewise 50% deeper than the quick-tach bucket models. This additional space makes them ideal for carrying irregular shaped loads like for example tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete and backfilling behind walls.

Quick-Tach Buckets

Quick-Tach Buckets are made for extendable-reach lift trucks. They are built to allow placement of materials way beyond the reach of a loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on both sides and on the leading edge reinforces strength, resistance to wear and tear and offers supreme durability. Quick-Tach lift truck buckets are augmented by scuff bars along the base of the unit which shield it from scrapes.

Quick-Tach lift buckets can in several situations substitute the blades and carriage of a forklift, that may weigh somewhere between one hundred to seven hundred pounds. These buckets when set up can free up more load capacity, enabling it to handle both bigger and heavier stuff. The Quick-Tach is able to pour stuff approximately 1.5 feet higher due to the shorter depth of its bucket. These buckets are designed in a customized fashion so as to suit the specs of particular makes and models of lifts.
