Forklift Seat - A sturdy surface to sit upon is called a seat. These Seats are usually raised above floor level and nearly all seats are supported by four legs and can carry a single person. A stool is a kind of seat which does not have a back or any arm rests. A kind of seat which has folding action and an inclining footrest is known as a recliner, while a seat along with arms only is considered an arm seat. If a seat has attached wheels, it can be referred to as a wheelseat and if the seat is hung from above, it is known as a swing. A permanently attached seat in a theatre or a train is called a seat or airline seat, yet when riding; it is a saddle as in bicycle saddle. A car seat is the type found inside automobiles and an infant car seat would be a seat particularly designed for young children.

The design of the seat can differ rather significantly in order to accommodate many requirements and aesthetic tastes. As an example, designs can be decorated with drilled holes, can include low backs or gaps for ventilation or be made of porous materials. The seat back could be designed as an included headrest by extending the height above the occupant's head. Seats may be constructed together with an attached, built in footrest or come with a separate matching ottoman. An ottoman is a short stool that is designed to be utilized as a movable footrest. From time to time the ottoman can be mounted to a glider chair with swing arms, allowing the ottoman to rock back and forth with the glider like a rocking chair with a built-in footrest.

Covers for seats are temporary fabric covers offering protections against wear or to offer improved aesthetics. Currently offered there are a broad array of seat covers from neoprene to leather. More formal materials can be rented for events such as weddings to improve the decoration. Some seat covers have decorative seat ties or ribbons attached to be tied at the back of the seat in a decorative know or ribbon. Various people utilize customized clear plastic furniture covers to protect their pricey sofas and seats.

Seat pads provide cushioning for hard seats, even though a few are usually decorative. Some could also be utilized in order to increase a driver's height within motor vehicles.
